Quiet and unassuming, these local eateries are hidden gems whose reputations generate a word-of-mouth following. (1) Slice of Waikīkī's name is befitting of its sliver of a location between two buildings. They make homemade pizzas, burgers and fries straight from their take-out window. (2) Japanese restaurant Chiba-Ken is always filled with patrons who occupy its 55-seat space on Ena Road. (3) Nestled across the Ala Wai Yacht Harbor is a local resident favorite called Chart House Waikīkī. They're known for their juicy steaks, seafood and panoramic sunset views.









Nothing says "vacation" or "getaway" like a full day of leisurely activities -or lack thereof. (1) From couples' massages to a hot stone spa called a ganban yoku, Spa Pure will leave you completely relaxed and in vacation mode. (2) Cruising is on the itinerary when visitors drive along the coast of the North Shore. Although the scenic route takes nearly two hours to drive from Waikīkī to Hale'iwa, the ocean view on every turn is rewarding. (3) To culminate an evening of relaxation, hop aboard the Star of Honolulu for a romantic dinner cruise.









As the sun sets along Waikīkī's shoreline, shades of sherbet orange, purple and pink will blanket across the sky, giving a heads-up that the bustling city is ready for you to see it in action. (1) Outrigger Reef Waikīkī Beach Resort presents live nightly Hawaiian music at Kani Ka Pila Grille. (2) For heart-pumping music, head over to the Sheraton Waikiki's Rum Fire and lounge along the fire pits while taking in a front row view of Diamond Head. (3) A couple blocks away, you'll find an oasis of jazz music at Outrigger Waikīkī Beach Resort's Blue Note Hawaii.
